



# THE NEW PATH TO SUCCESS

If you've been looking for work for a while with no success, talk to one of our staff members about the New Path to Success. We work with motivated job seekers who are serious about getting back to work (or find a better job) and willing to do what it takes to succeed. We've developed a structured approach to career coaching that includes one-on-one intensive work in addition to the job search you're already working on. We call it the New Path to Success, and we're inviting only a small group of job seekers into the program.

When we consider a candidate for New Path services, we look at several factors; we call them the Ready, Willing and Able factors.

- First, New Path candidates have to be ready to go to work. We need to know that any barriers they have are being resolved (like childcare and transportation.) They need to have work experience and be serious about passing a drug test if that's a requirement for getting hired. They have to be willing to take a suitable job when one appears; we'll work together to define and understand your criteria for a "good" job.
- We expect a bit more from our New Path customers. You'll need to dress for success every time you come into the center. You'll also need to be on time and prepared with any assignments you've been given. This level of professionalism is important to us since we'll be making direct referrals to our list of preferred employers. We want to make sure we can vouch personally for your professionalism and motivation.

Here's how the process works. Once we decide you're ready to become a New Path job seeker, we'll both sign a commitment form. You'll commit to the structure of the coaching practice and meeting our expectations, and we'll commit to your success.

## Here's what you'll get as a New Path Job Seeker:

- An individualized employment plan with the steps we'll take to get you your next job
- A career coach who will meet with you one-on-one to make sure you're prepared for a successful job search. You'll work together for up to 8 weeks, and periodically after that, to build a job search strategy, create a strong resume, build a great LinkedIn profile, prepare for interviews, and evaluate how things are going.
- We'll do a series of assessments to make sure your skills, experience, interests, and aptitudes are the right match for the job you've chosen to pursue. If something isn't quite where it needs to be, we can assist with remediation or other tools to get you where you need to be.
- We'll help you work on any other barriers to success, which may include referring to partner agencies that can help.



- We'll be available to point you to research resources, help coach you before and after interviews, and evaluate opportunities.
- You'll be eligible for invitation only employer recruitments and other benefits and services not available to most of our customers.

If you qualify for the New Path to Success, you may be assigned to work with a career coach who will help you with research, setting goals, retooling your resume and interview style, and helping you get a fresh start on your career transition.
