If you are a job seeker between the ages of 16 and 24, we can help you research careers and connect with employment and education opportunities. We also provide you with opportunities to interview and work with local employers and develop job readiness skills through workshops, work experience, apprenticeships, and job shadowing.

If you've dropped out of school, you know how hard it can be to find a good job. We can help you finish your GED and get you back onto a path to success. If you've graduated, but still find yourself struggling with reading math, or other issues that are holding you back, we'd like to talk with you. We can help you get work, and we can talk about quick, hands-on training options that get you ready for a good job with a future.

Each of our career centers has someone who specializes in working with young jobseekers. Our centers are open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and you don't need an appointment to come in.

At our career centers, you can use our resource room computers for your job search, to research companies, or work on your resume and cover letter. Our staff can help you with your search and give you information about other services available from community resources and partner agencies.

If you can't make it to a career center, you can connect with us at any of our Mobile Access Points. Mobile Access Teams were designed for people who have challenges in getting to a local career center. The Mobile Access Point teams rotate daily among churches, libraries, community centers and nonprofit organizations across the region. If you've been looking for work for a while and haven't found the right fit, talk to one of our staff members about the New Path to Success. We look for motivated jobseekers who are ready to commit to a structured approach to finding a job. If you qualify, you may be assigned to work with a career coach who will help you with research, setting goals, retooling your resume and interview style, and helping you get a fresh start on your career path.

We also have a number of special programs and partnerships designed to help young people get back on track, including those whose background includes a criminal record.
